So what does the word “baptize” mean?

Comes from the Greek βαπτίζω

See John 3:23; 8:38-39

If baptism could be accomplished through sprinkling or pouring water, then there were other words that could have been used, such as ραντίζω for sprinkling or ἐκχέω for pouring.

Significance of water baptism

What about passages such as Mark 1:4, Luke 3:3, Acts 2:38, Acts 22:16, 1 Corinthians 15:29 or 1 Peter 3:21?
